## Annual School Report

## Swimming

## New Security Fence

Our lovely new security fence has been completed. We are just waiting for locks and keys to make it fully operational. New procedures will apply once that is done. These procedures will include:

\*all gates except for the pedestrian gate in Stanley St will be locked during the day, so all visitors to the school will need to use this gate.

\*one gate on Burwood Rd and one gate on Salisbury St will be opened before school and at 2.45pm for students and parents to use.

\*the main driveway gate will also be locked during the day. **Only staff are allowed to park on school grounds.** ALL visitors, including parents dropping or picking up students from COOSH are to park in the streets surrounding the school.

## Parking and Student Safety

Children need to be closely supervised by a parent or adult carer when crossing the road or use the crossing provided in Stanley St. A number of

parents are practising unsafe driving habits by stopping in the middle of the school driveway to drop off their children who then walk through the double gates. I realise it has been difficult lately with the erection of the security fence but parents need to drop off their children safely at all times.
